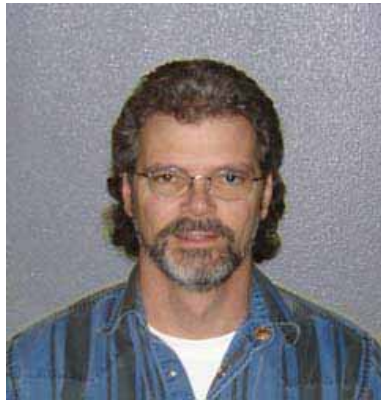
## Our Club's Super Tuesday
